D. Additional requirements

At Ovidius University of Constanta

- Academic admission requirements:
 - A minimum of English language level of B1. Our university accepts internationally recognized certificate (e.g. Cambridge, IELTS, TOEFL) but also certificates issued by the home university with the signature and stamp of the person responsible.
- Selection and Admission process:
 - The partner university must send their nominations to our university by email (uocpoffice@gmail.com) in the deadlines corresponding to each semester. For the winter semester the deadline is 1st of July and for the summer semester the deadline is 15th of December.
 - After the nomination, the Erasmus Office of Ovidius University of Constanta will schedule an interview between the nominated students and two representatives of the Erasmus Office.
 - After successfully passing the Skype interview, the student(s) will receive also by email the application procedure and all the necessary information and documents in order to successfully complete their application process
 - o After receiving the approval of the Erasmus Departmental Coordinator from within the faculty and of the Dean of the respective faculty, the Erasmus Office will issue the letter of acceptance, which will be signed by the Erasmus Institutional Coordinator and the Rector of Ovidius University of Constanta
- The Learning Agreement
 - The incoming students must consult the curriculum which will be send to them by email together with the application procedure email.
 - If the incoming students have any questions regarding the courses, they can contact directly our Departmental Coordinator, as the email address of the professor will be sent also with the application procedure
- Services for incoming students:
 - The Erasmus Office, together with our Departmental Coordinator are supporting our incoming student by offering them all the help and facilities they may need in order to successfully complete their study period abroad
 - The volunteer organization ESN, is helping the Erasmus Office, through a buddy system that they have implementing. Also, they are organizing at the beginning of each semester a welcome week, in which they are offering the incoming students the opportunity to familiarize themselves with our university and city.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [4] weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [4] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
